

RULES FOR PHOTOGRAPHY COMPETITION

ENTRIES CLOSE: Monday, 27 March 2023

ENTER: www.waikatoshow.co.nz

1. Open class – no age restriction. We want you to send through what you think is your best work. The only thing is, it has to be original work, not photoshopped from other images.
2. Please deliver or post your photography entries to Level 3, 800 Heaphy Terrace, Claudelands, Hamilton.
3. There will be first, second and third place winners. The first-place winner will receive a cash prize of \$100, second-place winner will receive a cash prize of \$50 and third place winner will receive a cash prize of \$25.
4. Entry fee is \$5 per photograph – You can either pay cash when you bring in your photograph or bank transfer (Please see below for details).
5. The photograph must be printed on photo paper and no smaller than an A4 size.
6. Please have black backing board, if you do not have this the Waikato Show will supply complementary backing paper before displaying for judging.
– please be aware this could leave a mark on your photograph.
7. Competitor must have name on back of each photograph
8. All fees need to be paid to the Waikato Show by 30th March 2023 – Please add name as reference (account details below)
9. All photos need to be delivered either through post or brought into the Waikato show office no later than 27th March 2023.
10. All entries will be available for collection as of 3rd April from the office at 800 Heaphy Terrace
 - If required to be posted or couriered back to exhibitor after completion, then please enclose a prepaid self-addressed envelope of suitable size.
11. Photos can be coloured or black and white. Entries will be judged by a suitably qualified person.
12. A public choice of best overall photograph will be a separate competition.
13. The competitor remains as sole owner of the photograph, however the competitor agrees to allow at no cost to the organisers of the Waikato Show the right to have copies of the photograph made and used for future promotional purposes.
14. The Waikato Show will endeavour to always protect the photographs from any damage or theft; however, the competitor accepts full responsibility of any said loss.
15. Judging will take place the week of the Show and winners will be displayed all weekend of the event. The event team will contact winners post event.
16. The judge's decision will be final, and no correspondence or discussions will be entered into thereafter.

The Waikato Show reserve the right not to display all entries if categories are oversubscribed.

If you have not received your prize by this 7th of April, please notify the office immediately. Notification must be made no later than the 14/04/23. Notification after this date will not be considered. If promised sponsorship is not forthcoming the Association cannot be held liable.

All entry fees and prizes are GST inclusive.

Any exhibitor who fails to comply with the rules, may forfeit their prize.
